



Dr. Kwung-Ping Fu Memorial Scholarship

In spring of 1996, Mrs. Vivian Y. G. Fu (the 9th NATWA President) decided to set up a scholarship fund in memory of her late husband, Dr. Kwung-Ping Fu. Two \$750 scholarship will be awarded this year to one female and one male recipient. Purpose of this scholarship is to encourage young Taiwanese Americans to participate in public affair. Taiwanese American students in their high school senior year or undergraduate years in college are qualified to apply. Applicants should demonstrate an interest in and understanding of their heritage by completing an internship in a non-profit Taiwanese American Organization with an established internship program. The internship must be for at least three weeks during the summer or winter break following the acceptance of the scholarship.

Application deadline for 2008 scholarship is June 24, 2008. Applicants should fill out the application form and send it with all the supporting documents to:

Please include the following with your application

- Two letters of recommendation
- An essay on what you would like to accomplish during the internship
- A confirmation letter from the sponsoring organization stating internship duration

Recipients will be announced in mid-July, 2008. It is also expected that the recipients submit a one- page report after their internship. The report is due two weeks after their internship.
